



Super Silicon

What's underneath Don Johnson's victory in the World Championships; the trans-Atlantic speed record attempts of Gentry and Azimut, and *Kiwi Magic's* impressive racing in the 1987 America's Cup? Kiss-Cote, a polymerized silicon formula invented by Dr. Keith Kent of Florida, is on all these winners' hulls. Kiss-Cote does three major things that boat owners can't argue with: It increases speed, reduces fuel consumption and lowers maintenance costs. It is environmentally safe and non-toxic; it prevents adhesion of marine organisms; protects all woods on board; resists extreme temperatures; protects finishes and fiberglass; is anti-corrosive, and more. A little goes a long way: Eight grams (pictured) will coat a smooth hull. Simply buff on, spread to coat the surface and wipe off the excess. No primer is necessary.
